

Very Wonky is here!

Finally, CB Industries has now come up with a Designer Mailbox for those who love angular design.

VeryWonky is a clear, cube Design Mailbox. With its 73° angle, it seems to stand somewhat askew, however. No wonder, since it stems from the pen of designer Carlo Borer, known for his dynamic forms.

The body of the elegant stainless-steel mailbox has a lockable mail compartment, its opening slit created to keep thieves out. The mailbox is attached to a painted metal base with the same 73° pitch.

The metal has been weatherproofed with an iron-phosphate coating prior to painting. The baked enamel finish is currently available in dark anthracite.

The mailbox base may be easily mounted on a concrete-encased component. Incidentally, this piece has also been weatherproofed with zinc coating.

Your Name or your street, with or without house number, may be cut from aluminum as an additional option. We use water jet cutting for the writing, and subsequently polish it to a high sheen, making your new mailbox into a definitively one-of-a kind, extravagant showpiece.

For more than one name, or names that are very long, an insertable nameplate is available, which we would be happy to label for you with laser printing.

Since both types of labeling for your mailbox can be subsequently attached, they may also be easily exchanged.

VeryWonky looks great before a Bauhaus masterpiece, of course, but it also fits well as a contrast to a farmhouse in the countryside or a townhouse in the suburbs.

VeryWonky also fits great into an **arrangement of more than one!** It is possible to mount two mailboxes on each base.

VeryWonky conforms to all requirements of the Swiss postal system in terms of dimensions.
